Other hazards Titanium dioxide is classified by IARC as a Group 2B carcinogen, meaning there is inadequate evidence in humans for the carcinogenicity of titanium dioxide, but there is sufficient evidence in experimental animals for the carcinogenicity of titanium dioxide.

Complete toxicity data are not available for this specific formulation.

Potential routes of overexposure to this product are skin and eye contact. Inhalation of vapor and ingestion are not expected to be significant routes of exposure for this product under normal use conditions.
